Art has always served as a reflection of current events. The Covid-19 pandemic is something that no one alive has experienced before and hopefully you will never again experience in your lifetime.

For our final project I want you to document your experiences during this time. I think your creation will be something that you will look back on and remember this time in your life in a way that only art can provide.

You have several choices for how you would like to document your daily events visually. I would like for you to focus on this week as a snapshot into the whole experience but if you want to include events from the entire time that is fine too. Seniors you can focus on missed events as well.

Use this week to take note of your daily routines-even if they are simple or mundane (the simplicity of your daily life might be the focus), consider your struggles and successes. Document things you have learned about your family or about yourself during this time. It may be something monumental or it may be something that seems insignificant but that you have observed.

After you have gathered your thoughts about what pieces of your daily life you would like to document, decide how you will represent or remember this time period.

Your choices include:

Photo journal (include at least 15 images)

Can include words or written descriptions

Can be still photos or video format

Visual Journal (At least 10 drawn images)

Should include words and written journaling in a visually appealing format

Collage (should be at least 12x 18 in size)

Can include images, words, take out wrappers, mail, etc. Get creative with what you include

Visual Interview

Can include images and words from insight from family members

Painting (12 x 18 in size)

Should capture and record your life at this point in time

If you have another idea that is not listed feel free to email me the details. You have two weeks to complete this so please put a lot of effort into the work. I believe that it will serve as a great reminder of these unprecedented times.
