Implied
A texture that looks like you could feel it but is, in actual fact, flat to the touch


For the TEXTURE project you are going to create a texture sample board. It should contain 12 different textures. They will be created individually on 2 " $\times 2$ " squares.

- 4 of the 12 will be actual textures (gluing on to create something you can touch)
- 4 of the 12 will be implied textures that you have drawn. Take your time, it is a slow process to make them look real. They can be in color or in black and white.
- 4 of the 12 will be texture rubbings that you create with textured surfaces and crayons.

Once you have all 12 of your samples complete, assemble them in a visually appealing format. They should be evenly spaced, straight, clean (no glue showing) and balanced (vary the color and texture placement).
